

General Information

Requirements of Scholarship

- Students must agree to mentoring as an ADP STEM scholar which will require 2-3 quarterly visits with an assigned advisor to determine progress in the program and to intervene if additional tutoring or learning assistance is needed.
- The student must meet the standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
- If a student does not make SAP quarterly (2.0 GPA, 67% completion rate), the student will be removed from the program and will be replaced with another candidate.
- Students in the ADP STEM Scholars Program must remain continuously enrolled from quarter to quarter until program completion.
- A student may only have one lapse in quarterly attendance. If a lapse occurs a second time, the student will be removed and will be replaced with another candidate.

Recommendation for awarding scholarship

- Scholarships will be awarded in quarterly increments of \$1,000 if a student is making satisfactory academic progress.
- Awards will be made to a student's account and any remaining unused funds will be awarded to the student during the regular financial aid reimbursement period which is typically the 28th day of the quarter and the last day of the quarter.
- No Financial Aid exclusions (scholarship recipient can also receive other sources of financial aid, i.e. HOPE, Pell)

Additional funding by the ADP STEM Scholarship

- Additional scholarship monies may be available for certification fees in the form of reimbursement scholarships.
- A student designated as an ADP STEM Scholar can be recommended by his/her CIS instructor for reimbursement scholarship if he/she is making satisfactory adequate progress in his/her program of study.
- A reimbursement scholarship will pay for certifications. A student will have to provide a paid receipt and proof of successful certification before an additional reimbursement scholarship will be awarded.

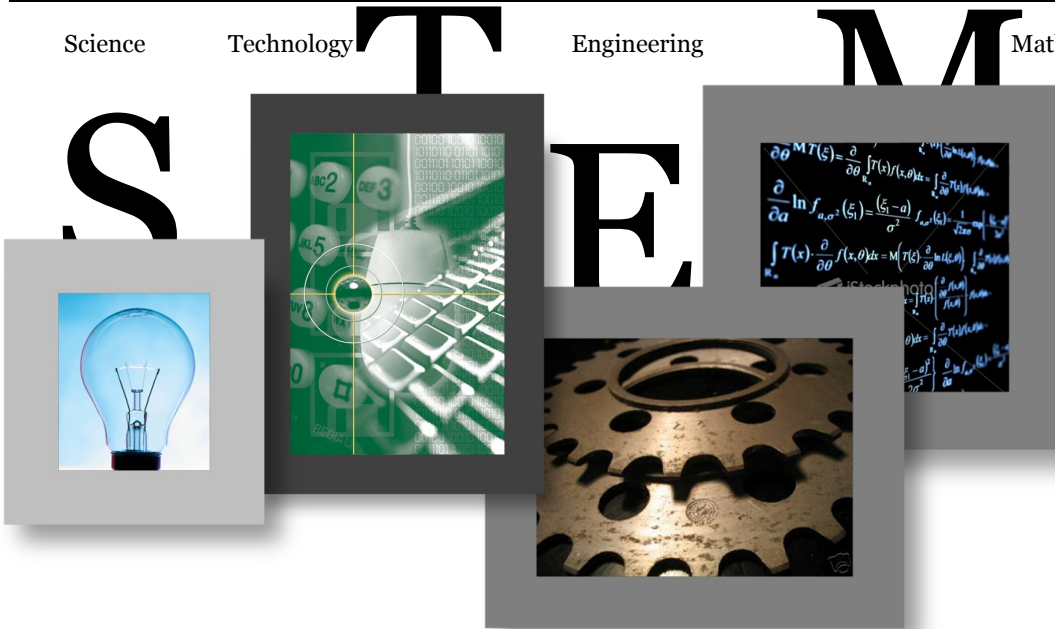
